## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT AMENDING ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-62-107 TO  
10 LIMIT THE AMOUNT THAT FOUR-YEAR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
11 EDUCATION CAN SPEND ON REMEDIATION OF STUDENTS; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AMENDING A.C.A. § 6-62-107 TO LIMIT THE  
15 AMOUNT THAT FOUR-YEAR INSTITUTIONS OF  
16 HIGHER EDUCATION CAN SPEND ON  
17 REMEDIATION OF STUDENTS."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21  
22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-62-107(b) is amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 "(b) Beginning with the ~~1994~~ 1997 fall semester, a public four-year  
25 institution of higher education in Arkansas may spend no more for remediation  
26 of students twenty-one (21) years of age and younger than the amount of state  
27 funds expended by the institution on remediation during the 1992-1993 or  
28 1994-1995 academic year, whichever is greater."

29  
30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33  
34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
36 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
