16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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18	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-14-104 is amended to read as follows:	
19	"5-14-104. Carnal abuse in the first degree.	
20	(a) A person commits carnal abuse in the first degree if, being under	
21	the age of eighteen (18) years, he engages in sexual intercourse or deviate	
22	sexual activity with another person not his spouse who is less than fourteen	
23	(14) years old. It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this	
24	subsection that the actor was not more than two (2) years older than the	
25	victim.	
26	(b) Carnal abuse in the first degree is a Class A felony for the first	-
27	offense and a Class Y felony for the second and subsequent offenses."	
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29	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 5-14-105 is amended to read as follows:	
30	"5-14-105. Carnal abuse in the second degree.	
31	(a) A person commits carnal abuse in the second degree if he engages i	.n
32	sexual intercourse or deviate sexual activity with another person not his	
33	spouse who is incapable of consent because he is mentally defective or	
34	mentally incapacitated.	
35	(b) Carnal abuse in the second degree is a Class C felony for the firs	;t
36	offense, a Class B felony for the second offense, and a Class A felony for th	ıe

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- 3 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 5-14-106 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 "5-14-106. Carnal abuse in the third degree.
- 5 (a) A person commits carnal abuse in the third degree if, being twenty
- 6 (20) years old or older, he engages in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual
- 7 activity with another person not his spouse who is less than sixteen (16)
- 8 years old.
- 9 (b) Carnal abuse in the third degree is a Class D felony for the first
- 10 offense, a Class C felony for the second offense, and a Class B felony for the
- 11 third and subsequent offenses."

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- 13 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 5-14-107 is amended to read as follows:
- "5-14-107. Sexual misconduct.
- 15 (a) A person commits sexual misconduct if he engages in sexual
- 16 intercourse or deviate sexual activity with another person not his spouse who
- 17 is less than sixteen (16) years old.
- 18 (b) Sexual misconduct is a Class B misdemeanor for the first offense, a
- 19 Class A misdemeanor for the second offense, and a Class D felony for the third
- 20 and subsequent offenses."

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- 22 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 5-14-108 is amended to read as follows:
- "5-14-108. Sexual abuse in the first degree.
- 24 (a) A person commits sexual abuse in the first degree if:
- 25 (1) He engages in sexual contact with another person by forcible
- 26 compulsion; or
- 27 (2) He engages in sexual contact with another person who is incapable
- 28 of consent because he is physically helpless; or
- 29 (3) Being eighteen (18) years old or older, he engages in sexual
- 30 contact with a person not his spouse who is less than fourteen (14) years old;
- 31 or
- 32 (4) He engages in sexual contact with a person who is less than sixteen
- 33 (16) years of age and who is incapable of consent because he is mentally
- 34 defective or mentally incapacitated.
- 35 (b) Sexual abuse in the first degree is a Class C felony for the first
- 36 offense, a Class B felony for the second offense, and a Class A felony for the

1 third and subsequent offenses."

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- 3 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 5-14-109 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 "5-14-109. Sexual abuse in the second degree.
- 5 (a) A person commits sexual abuse in the second degree if:
- 6 (1) He or she engages in sexual contact with another person not his or
- 7 her spouse who is incapable of consent because he or she is mentally defective
- 8 or mentally incapacitated;
- 9 (2) Being less than eighteen (18) years old, he or she engages in
- 10 sexual contact with a person not his or her spouse who is less than fourteen
- 11 (14) years old. It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
- 12 subdivision (a)(2) that the actor was not more than two (2) years older than
- 13 the victim; or
- 14 (3) He or she, being employed directly or through contract with the
- 15 Department of Correction or the Department of Community Punishment, engages in
- 16 sexual contact for the purpose of sexual gratification with any person in the
- 17 custody of the Department of Correction or the Department of Community
- 18 Punishment, the consent of the person in custody notwithstanding.
- 19 (b) Sexual abuse in the second degree is a Class A misdemeanor for the
- 20 first offense, a Class D felony for the second offense, and a Class C felony
- 21 for the third and subsequent offenses."

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- 23 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 5-14-110 is amended to read as follows:
- 24 "5-14-110. Sexual solicitation of a child.
- 25 (a) A person commits sexual solicitation of a child if, being eighteen
- 26 (18) years old or older, he solicits any person not his spouse who is less
- 27 than fourteen (14) years old to engage in sexual intercourse, deviate sexual
- 28 activity, or sexual contact.
- 29 (b) Sexual solicitation of a child is a Class D felony for the first
- 30 offense, a Class C felony for the second offense, and a Class B felony for the
- 31 third and subsequent offenses."

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- 33 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code 5-14-120 is amended to read as follows:
- 34 "5-14-120. Violation of a minor in the first degree.
- 35 (a) A person commits the offense of violation of a minor in the first
- 36 degree if he engages in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual activity with

- 1 another person not his spouse, who is more than thirteen (13) years of age and
- 2 less than eighteen (18) years of age, and the actor is the minor's guardian,
- 3 an employee in the minor's school or school district, a temporary caretaker,
- 4 or a person in a position of trust or authority of the minor.
- 5 (b) Violation of a minor in the first degree is a Class C felony for
- 6 the first offense, a Class B felony for the second offense, and a Class A
- 7 felony for the third and subsequent offenses."

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- 9 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code 5-14-121 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 "5-14-121. Violation of a minor in the second degree.
- 11 (a) A person commits the offense of violation of a minor in the second
- 12 degree if he engages in sexual contact with another person not his spouse, who
- 13 is more than thirteen (13) years of age and less than eighteen (18) years of
- 14 age, and the actor is the minor's guardian, an employee in the minor's school
- 15 or school district, a temporary caretaker, or a person in a position of trust
- 16 or authority of the minor.
- 17 (b) Violation of a minor in the second degree is a Class D felony for
- 18 the first offense, a Class C felony for the second offense, and a Class B
- 19 felony for the third and subsequent offenses."

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- 21 SECTION 10. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
- 22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
- 23 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 25 SECTION 11. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 29 act are declared to be severable.

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- 31 SECTION 12. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 32 hereby repealed.

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
