SENATE BILL 749

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF COMMISSIONER EMERITUS
10 FOR THE STATE KIDNEY DISEASE COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF
15 COMMISSIONER EMERITUS FOR THE STATE
16 KIDNEY DISEASE COMMISSION"

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. (a) Any person who has served, is now serving, or serves in
21 the future as a member of the State Kidney Disease Commission, as established
22 by A.C.A. §§ 20-15-601 through 20-15-605, or its predecessor commissions, and
23 who has served or serves twenty-four (24) years as a member of the commission,
24 or its predecessor commission, shall be eligible to be known and designated as
25 a "Commissioner Emeritus" if the Governor so appoints.

26 (b) A commissioner emeritus shall serve as a member of the State Kidney
27 Disease Commission for the remainder of his or her life and shall be notified
28 of all commission meeting, shall be eligible to vote, and shall be entitled to
29 the same expenses and other allowances for attending commission meeting as is
30 provided by law for other commission members.

31 (c) The Governor shall cause an appropriate commission to be prepared
32 and issued to each commissioner emeritus of the State Kidney Disease
33 Commission. The commissioner emeritus shall file the commission with the
34 Secretary of State and take the official oath of office before entering upon
35 his duties as a commissioner emeritus of the commission.

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
