9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
10 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE POST PRISON TRANSFER BOARD
11 WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
12 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 195 OF 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT FOR THE POST PRISON TRANSFER
15 BOARD SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Post
21 Prison Transfer Board, the following maximum number of regular employees which
22 shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section
23 1 of Act 195 of 1995 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of
24 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
25 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
26 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
27 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

3 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Post
4 Prison Transfer Board, to be payable from the State General Services Fund
5 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Post Prison
6 Transfer Board which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
7 appropriated in Section 2 of Act 195 of 1995, the following:

22 SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of
23 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books
24 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of forty-four thousand three hundred
25 twenty-one dollars (\$44,321) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund
26 to the State General Services Fund Account to provide funds for the
27 appropriation provided herein.

28

29 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
30 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
32 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
35 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

1 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3

4 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
5 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
6 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
7 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
8 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
9 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
11 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12

13 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
14 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
15 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16

17 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
18 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
19 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
20 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
21 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

22

23 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
24 with this Act are hereby repealed.

25

26 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
27 Eighty-First General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for
28 the operations of the Post Prison Transfer Board are, due to unforeseen
29 circumstances, insufficient for the Post Prison Transfer Board to continue to
30 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will
31 provide the necessary monies for the Post Prison Transfer Board to continue
32 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
33 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
34 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
35 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
2 date of its passage and approval.
