20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-16-904 is amended to read as follows:

- 14 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 15 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 16 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 18 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 19 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 20 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 22 act are declared to be severable.

- 24 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 25 hereby repealed.

- 27 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
- 28 Assembly that Act 1211 of 1995 failed to authorize payment of a stipend to
- 29 members of the boards of trustees of the Arkansas School for the Blind and the
- 30 Arkansas School for the Deaf for attending meetings of the board; and that
- 31 this act is designed to correct this inequity and should be given effect
- 32 immediately. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
- 33 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
- 34 safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If
- 35 the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
- 36 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor

1 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 2 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the 3 veto.
