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24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-102 is amende	d to read as	
25	follows:

28	(a) (1) Subject to confirmation by the Governor, the The	State Board	of
29	Education and the State Board of Vocational Education are empo	wered to empl	.oy
30	persons to act as the Director of General Education and the Di	rector of	
31	Vocational and Technical Education, who shall serve at the ple	asure of <del>the</del>	
32	Governor their respective boards.		
33	(2) It is the specific intention of this subsecti	on to define	and
34	declare the Director of General Education to be the employee o	f the State	
35	Board of Education and the Director of Vocational and Technica	l Education t	.0
36	be the employee of the State Board of Vocational Education.		

- 1 (b) The directors shall devote all of their time to the duties of their
- 2 offices, shall act as agents of the boards, and perform such other duties as
- 3 are designated by the boards or by statute.
- 4 (c)(1) The person selected as the Director of General Education must:
- 5 (A) Be a person of good moral character, recognized as a
- 6 leader in the field of education, qualified technically and by experience to
- 7 direct the work of the Department of Education;
- 8 (B) Hold the master's degree from an accredited
- 9 institution;
- 10 (C) Have had ten (10) years' experience as a teacher, five
- 11 (5) of which must be of an administrative or supervisory nature; and
- 12 (D) Hold a valid state teacher's certificate.
- 13 (2) No person who is related within the fourth degree of
- 14 consanguinity or affinity to any member of the State Board of Education shall
- 15 be eligible to serve as Director of General Education.
- 16 (d)(1) The person selected as Director of Vocational and Technical
- 17 Education must:
- 18 (A) Be a person of good moral character, recognized as a
- 19 leader in the field of vocational education, qualified technically and by
- 20 experience to direct the work of the Vocational and Technical Education
- 21 Division;
- 22 (B) Hold the master's degree from an accredited
- 23 institution;
- 24 (C) Have had ten (10) years' experience as a teacher,
- 25 supervisor, and administrator of vocational education, with the experience
- 26 representing positions of increasing responsibility; and
- 27 (D) Qualify as a teacher in a vocational program area under
- 28 the state board's standard qualification requirements.
- 29 (2) No person who is related within the fourth degree of
- 30 consanguinity or affinity to any member of the State Board of Vocational
- 31 Education shall be eligible to serve as Director of Vocational and Technical
- 32 Education.
- 33 (e) It is the specific intention of this act to define and declare the
- 34 Director of General Education to be the employee of the State Board of
- 35 Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education to be the
- 36 employee of the State Board of Vocational Education.

- $1 \frac{(f)}{(e)}(1)$  The Director of General Education, or a disbursing agent
- 2 designated by him and approved by the State Board of Education, and the
- 3 Director of Vocational and Technical Education, or a disbursing agent
- 4 designated by him and approved by the State Board of Vocational Education,
- 5 shall give bond to the State of Arkansas as provided by law for other
- 6 disbursing agents, conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties
- 7 and the faithful accounting for all the school money of the state, of any
- 8 county, or of any school district that may come into their hands.
- 9 (2) The bond shall be in a solvent surety company having a right
- 10 to do business in the State of Arkansas and shall be approved by the State
- 11 Board of Education.
- 12 (3) The premium on the bond shall be paid by the State Board of
- 13 Education as one of the expenses of the board.
- (g) The state shall furnish the directors with suitable offices."

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- 16 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 20 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
- 24 act are declared to be severable.

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- 26 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
- 27 hereby repealed.

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- 29 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-
- 30 First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the immediate
- 31 effectiveness of this act is necessary to clarify the law in regard to who has
- 32 authority to dismiss the Director of Vocational and Technical Education and
- 33 the Director of General Education and is essential to the operation of both
- 34 divisions of the Department of Education. Therefore, an emergency is declared
- 35 to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
- 36 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its

1 approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the 2 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time 3 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the 4 Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the 5 last house overrides the veto.
