7	SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
8	SERVING NOTICE AND DEMAND ON THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO
9	CEASE AND DESIST FROM ISSUING MANDATES TO THE STATES THAT
10	ARE BEYOND THE SCOPE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS
11	CONSTITUTIONALLY DELEGATED POWER.

14	SERVING NOTICE AND DEMAND ON THE FEDERAL
15	GOVERNMENT TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM
16	ISSUING MANDATES TO THE STATES THAT ARE
17	BEYOND THE SCOPE OF THE FEDERAL
18	GOVERNMENTS CONSTITUTIONALLY DELEGATED
19	POWER.

21	WHEREAS, the 10th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States
22	read as follows:
23	"The powers not delegated to the United States by the
24	Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States
25	respectively, or to the people."; and
26	WHEREAS, the 10th Amendment defines the total scope of federal power as
27	being that specifically granted by the United States Constitution and no more;
28	and
29	WHEREAS, the scope of power defined by the 10th Amendment means that the
30	federal government was created by the states specifically to be an agent of
31	the states; and
32	WHEREAS, today, in 1997, the states are demonstrably treated as agents
33	of the federal government; and
34	WHEREAS, many federal mandates are directly in violation of the 10th
35	Amendment to the Constitution of the United States; and
36	WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has ruled in New York v. United

- 1 States, 112 S. Ct. 2408 (1992), that Congress may not simply commandeer the
- 2 legislative and regulatory processes of the states; and
- 3 WHEREAS, a number of proposals from previous administrations and some
- 4 now pending from the present administration and from Congress may further
- 5 violate the United States Constitution;

- 7 NOW THEREFORE,
- 8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
- 9 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

10

- 11 (1) That the State of Arkansas hereby claims sovereignty under the 10th
- 12 Amendment to the Constitution of the United States over all powers not
- 13 otherwise enumerated and granted to the federal government by the United
- 14 States Constitution.
- 15 (2) That this serve as Notice and Demand to the federal government, as
- 16 our agent, to cease and desist, effective immediately, mandates that are
- 17 beyond the scope of its constitutionally delegated powers.

- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,
- 20 That copies of this Resolution be sent by the Secretary of the Senate to
- 21 the President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States House of
- 22 Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 23 House and the President of the Senate of each states legislature of the
- 24 United States of America, and Arkansas Congressional delegation.
