17 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act was adopted in 1967;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the act has been amended numerous times in the past thirty  
20 years; and

21 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to begin a comprehensive study of the  
22 Administrative Procedure Act; and

23 WHEREAS, a review of the law by the Arkansas Bar Association would be  
24 helpful to the Arkansas General Assembly in considering whether the law needs  
25 to be revised and updated,

27 NOW THEREFORE,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE  
29 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

31 THAT the members of the Arkansas Senate and the House of Representatives  
32 request the Arkansas Bar Association to undertake a study of the Arkansas  
33 Administrative Procedure Act for the purpose of determining whether  
34 comprehensive revisions are needed. In conducting the study the Arkansas Bar  
35 Association is requested to include the members of the Arkansas Senate and  
36 House Judiciary Committees on the committee to study the issue. The report is

1 requested to be completed by September 1, 1998.
