14 PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE
15 REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST
16 GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL THE CLOSE OF
17 BUSINESS ON FRIDAY, MARCH 21, 1997.

19 WHEREAS, Section 17 of Article V of the Constitution of the State of
20 Arkansas provides that the regular biennial session of the General Assembly
21 shall not exceed sixty days in duration, unless extended by a vote of two-
22 thirds of the members elected to each house of the General Assembly; and

23 WHEREAS, it now appears that the regular session of the Eighty-First
24 General Assembly will be unable to complete the essential business of this
25 session within sixty days, and that an extension of this regular session will
26 be necessary for the completion of the business of this session,

28 NOW THEREFORE,

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
30 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

32 That the regular session of the Eighty-First General Assembly of the
33 State of Arkansas is hereby extended through the close of business in each
34 house on Friday, March 21, 1997, at which time the 1997 regular session shall
35 be adjourned sine die unless it is determined that a further extension is
36 necessary to complete the business of the session.
