19 WHEREAS, Monday, January 20, 1997, is a state holiday in honor of the  
20 birthdays of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and Robert E. Lee; and

22 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 1-5-102(b) requires all state offices located in  
23 Pulaski County to maintain at least a skeleton crew on state holidays  
24 occurring during any session of the General Assembly unless the General  
25 Assembly adopts a resolution permitting those offices to be closed; and

27 WHEREAS, the General Assembly will be in recess on Monday, January 20,  
28 1997, by virtue of Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1;

30 NOW THEREFORE,

31 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE  
32 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

34 That the state offices located within Pulaski County may close on  
35 Monday, January 20, 1997, in celebration of the state holiday honoring the  
36 birthdays of Martin Luther King, Jr. and Robert E. Lee.
