7 **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THAT THE DEADLINE FOR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL  
9 ASSEMBLY TO FILE PROPOSED LEGISLATION AFFECTING PUBLICLY  
10 SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEMS SHALL BE EXTENDED THROUGH  
11 FEBRUARY 17TH, 1997.

14 REQUESTING THAT THE DEADLINE TO FILE  
15 PUBLIC RETIREMENT BILLS SHALL BE  
16 EXTENDED THROUGH FEBRUARY 17TH, 1997.

18 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 10-2-115 provides that any legislation  
19 affecting any public supported retirement system shall be introduced and  
20 considered by the Arkansas General Assembly only if it is introduced during  
21 the first thirty (30) days of the legislative session, unless three-fourths  
22 (3/4ths) of the full membership of each house of the Arkansas General Assembly  
23 approves of the introduction; and

25 WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 10-2-115 further provides that if the Arkansas  
26 General Assembly recesses for more than three (3) consecutive days then the  
27 30-day deadline will be automatically extended for the same number of days as  
28 the recess; and

30 WHEREAS, Senate Concurrent Resolution 1 adopted by the General Assembly  
31 called for the recess of the Eighty-First General Assembly from January 17th  
32 till January 22nd and since February 16th, 1997 falls on a weekend day of  
33 Sunday,

35 NOW THEREFORE,

36 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE

1 OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

3 THAT the deadline for members of the Eighty-First Arkansas General

4 Assembly to file legislation affecting any public supported retirement system

5 shall be extended through February 17th, 1997.
