17 WHEREAS, littering and illegal dumping in Arkansas is a chronic problem;

20 WHEREAS, over two years ago the Georgia-Pacific Corporation initiated an
21 ambitious program known as "Pick-up Arkansas"; and

23 WHEREAS, the "Pick-up Arkansas" campaign now boasts over twenty partners
24 including state agencies, professional and business associations, and private
25 corporations; and

27 WHEREAS, the County Judges Association unanimously endorsed the program
28 in 1996 and agreed to participate; and

30 WHEREAS, the goals of "Pick-up Arkansas" are a statewide educational
31 initiative to inform Arkansans of problems and solutions to littering and
32 illegal dumping; a statewide clean-up of roadsides, shorelines, parks and
33 other public areas; a statewide clean-up and closure of illegal dumps in
34 Arkansas; and a follow-up educational and law enforcement program that will
35 teach our citizens to properly dispose of trash and punish those who continue
36 to violate the law;
