14 "AN ACT TO PERMIT FREEZE BRANDING. "

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-34-201(5) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(5) 'Brand' means a permanent identification burned or frozen into the
21 hide of a live animal with a hot iron or hot or frozen chemical in letters,
22 numbers, or figures, each of which is at least three inches (3") in overall
23 length or diameter and is to be considered in relation to its location on the
24 animal. "

25
26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29
30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 Act are declared to be severable.

36 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are

1 hereby repealed.
