SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-16-802(a) is amended to read as follows:
"(a)(1) Any person who is at least fourteen (14) years of age may apply
to the office for an instruction permit.

28 (2) The office may, in its discretion, after the applicant has 29 successfully passed all parts of the examination other than the driving test, issue to the applicant an instruction permit which shall entitle the applicant 30 31 while having the permit in his immediate possession to drive a motor vehicle upon the public highways for a period of $\frac{1}{100}$ days six (6) months when 32 accompanied by a licensed driver, eighteen (18) years of age or older, who has 33 34 had at least one (1) year of driving experience and who is occupying a seat 35 beside the driver, except in the event the permittee is operating a motorcycle. 36

If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
