6 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas 7 Tobacco Control Board for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from 8 9 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the 10 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for 11 12 the appropriate classification.

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14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas 15 Tobacco Control Board, to be payable from the State General Services Fund 16 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Tobacco Control Board for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following: 17 18

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SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 32 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 33 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 34 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 35 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 36

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Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 6 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 8 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 11 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 13 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application 20 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall 21 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given 22 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 23 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

25 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 26 this act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 28 29 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas 30 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that 31 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 36
