Every agency of this state which has direct contact with 27 parents of young children shall make every effort to educate parents as to the risk of harm to children left alone in motor vehicles. Agencies are directed 28 29 to utilize every avenue, including public service announcements and 30 participation in public gatherings, to inform parents of the risk of harm to young children left unattended in motor vehicles and the penalties for leaving 31 32 children left unattended in motor vehicles. 33 All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 34 SECTION 2. 35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 36
