Arkansas Code § 24-5-119 is hereby amended to read as 23 follows: Redetermination of benefits. 24 *4* 24 - 5 - 119. (a) Beginning with the July 1 which is at least twelve (12) full months 25 after the effective date of each benefit, the amount of each benefit shall be 26 redetermined, and the redetermined amount shall be payable for the ensuing 27 28 year. 29 (b) (1) Subject to the maximum stated in subdivision (b) (2) of this section, the The redetermined amount shall be the amount of the benefit 30 31 otherwise payable as of the immediately preceding July 1, increased by three 32 percent (3%). 33 (2) In no event shall the redetermined amount be less than the amount of the benefit otherwise payable or more than the amount of the benefit 34 otherwise payable multiplied by the following fraction, subject to a maximum 35 of three percent (3%): the numerator shall be the consumer price index for the 36

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1	twelfth calendar month in the calendar year immediately preceding July 1, but
2	in no event an amount less than the denominator, which shall be the consumer
3	price index for the twelfth calendar month in the calendar year immediately
4	preceding the numerator.
5	(3) As used in this subsection:
6	(A) 'The amount of the benefit otherwise payable' means the
7	full amount of the monthly benefit that would be payable disregarding the
8	provisions of this section redetermining the benefit amounts after retirement;
9	and and
10	(B)(i) 'Consumer price index' means the Consumer Price Index
11	for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers, as determined by the United
12	States Department of Labor, in effect January 1, 1969, and revised January
13	<del>1978.</del>
14	(ii) Should the consumer price index be restructured
15	subsequent to 1978 in a manner materially changing its character, the Board of
16	Trustees of the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System, after
17	receiving the advice of the actuary, shall change the application of the
18	consumer price index so that, as far as practicable, the 1968 and 1978 intent
19	of the use of the consumer price index shall be continued."
20	
21	SECTION 2. <u>No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be</u>
22	implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's
23	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year
24	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be
25	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial
26	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years
27	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than
28	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.
29	
30	SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
31	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
33	
34	SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
35	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36	other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without

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1	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
2	Act are declared to be severable.
3	
4	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
5	hereby repealed.
6	
7	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
8	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that benefits provided under the Arkansas
9	State Highway Employees' Retirement System are inadequate and that an
10	increase should be provided as soon as practicable in order to avoid an undue
11	hardship. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
12	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety,
13	shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 1999.
