All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 24 hereby repealed. 25 26 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 27 Eighty-second General Assembly that certain Teacher Retirement System 28 retirants, for personal reasons which they do not wish disclosed, may want to 29 suspend their benefits, that providing retirants with this option leaves the 30 system open to question about liability for these suspended benefits and the 31 law needs clarification in this situation, and that the most effective time to 32 make changes to the retirement system is at the beginning of the state's 33 fiscal year and therefore this act should take effect immediately at that time. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being 34 35 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on July 1, 1999. 36

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
