- (e) During any period of employment in a position covered by the system, a retirant shall not accrue additional credited service nor shall he contribute to the system.
- (f) In accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the State Board of Education, the Arkansas Department of Education may request of the Teacher Retirement System Board of Trustees, or its designee, a waiver of the conditions subjecting annuities to limitations. If approved by the Board of Trustees, or its designee, the waiver shall be effective for a one (1) year period, with the option to review annually as requested by the Arkansas Department of Education."

SECTION 2. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
