## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
10 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS  
11 SYSTEM ADMINISTRATION - COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE-  
12 RETIREMENT AND RELOCATION PROMOTION PROGRAM WHICH  
13 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
14 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 985 OF 1997; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES. "

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26  
27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE-RETIREMENT AND  
28 RELOCATION PROMOTION PROGRAM-SUPPLEMENTAL. There is hereby appropriated, to  
29 the University of Arkansas System Administration, to be payable from the  
30 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for personal  
31 services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas System  
32 Administration - Cooperative Extension Service-Retirement and Relocation  
33 Promotion Program which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds  
34 appropriated in Section 2 of Act 985 of 1997, the following:

12 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by  
 13 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
 14 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions  
 15 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures  
 16 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and  
 17 Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their  
 18 successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and  
 19 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as  
 20 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said  
 21 funds.

23 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
 30 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
 33 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
 34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application

1 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
2 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
3 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
4 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

5  
6 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
7 this act are hereby repealed.

8  
9 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
10 Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly  
11 for the operations of the University of Arkansas System Administration are,  
12 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the University of Arkansas  
13 System Administration to continue to provide essential governmental services;  
14 that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the  
15 University of Arkansas System Administration to continue such services; and  
16 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm  
17 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
18 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
21 passage and approval.

22 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
23 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
24 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
25 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the  
26 veto.
