BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 26-52-401, whi ch exempts certain items from the Arkansas Gross Recei pts Tax, is amended to add the following new subdi vi si on to be appropriately numbered by the Arkansas Code Revi sion Commi ssi on:
"Gross recei pts or gross proceeds derived from a sal e to an emergency medical service provider of emergency medi cal equi prent used directly in the del i very of emergency medical services to a patient."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ his act of a general and permanent nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nvalid, such i nval idity shall not affect
ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
