22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
25 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
26 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
27 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
28 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
29 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
30 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
31 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
32 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
33 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
34 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State
 5 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
 6 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 7 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein
 8 for such purposes: twenty (20) temporary or part-time employees, when needed,
 9 at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and
 10 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 11 classification.
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13 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 14 State Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination,
 15 to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer
 16 of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State
 17 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
 18 biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

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 34 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 35 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
 36 The remaining balance as of June 30, ~~1998~~, 2000, of unexpended appropriation

1 in Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into fiscal year ~~1998-99~~ 2000-01 to
 2 be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year.

3
 4 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 5 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 6 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 7 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 8 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 9 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 10 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 12 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 14 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 21 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

22
 23 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 24 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 25 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26
 27 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
 28 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 29 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 30 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 31 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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 33 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 34 this act are hereby repealed.

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 36 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
2 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
3 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
7 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.

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
