20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ADFA OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 1999-2001 biennium, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed
25 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas
26 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
28 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
32 successor.

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31 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - ADFA OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 32 to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable from cash funds
 33 as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Development Finance
 34 Authority, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
 35 Development Finance Authority for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001,

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in Item (06) of Section 2 of this Act shall be in accordance with the State of Arkansas Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy developed and administered by the Arkansas Development Finance Authority and shall be in accordance with project requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME Program.

SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized in Item (06) of Section 2 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ended June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Development Finance Authority shall report

1 quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council the total expenditures in the
2 Arkansas Home Equity Loan Program, Farmer MAC Guaranteed Loan Program, and
3 Agricultural Loan Mediation and Development Program.

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5 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
6 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
7 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
8 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
9 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
10 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
11 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
12 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
13 with in disbursement of said funds.

14
15 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
22 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
25 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
26 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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28 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
29 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
30 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
31 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
32 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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34 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
35 this act are hereby repealed.

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
