26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-17-106(a) is amended to read as
29 follows:

30 " (a) ~~Any person who shall abuse~~ Abuse or insult of a public school
31 ~~teacher employee~~ while that ~~teacher employee~~ employee is performing normal and regular
32 or assigned school responsibilities ~~shall be guilty of~~ is a misdemeanor and
33 ~~upon conviction~~ any person pleading guilty or nolo contendere to or found
34 guilty of such offense shall be liable for a fine of not less than one hundred
35 dollars (\$100) nor more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500). "

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 Act are declared to be severable.

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
12 hereby repealed.
