It is the intent of the General Assembly 4 5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 6 7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 11 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

17 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application 18 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall 19 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given 20 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the 21 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

23 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 24 this act are hereby repealed.

26 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 27 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the current contribution level for 28 continuing education for county officials is insufficient and when the 29 contribution level is raised, the appropriation for this purpose is 30 insufficient. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999. 33 /s/ Cook 34 35

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
