16 "AN ACT TO ALLOW SHERIFF DEPUTIES TO  
17 PURCHASE THEIR COUNTY ISSUED FIREARMS  
18 UPON RETIREMENT OR OTHERWISE HONORABLY  
19 LEAVING THE SHERIFF'S EMPLOYMENT; AND

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24  
25 SECTION 1. When any sheriff's deputy retires or otherwise honorably  
26 terminates employment with the sheriff, the officer may purchase any firearm  
27 which had been issued to the officer by the sheriff. The sheriff, with the  
28 approval of the county judge, may sell the firearm to the deputy at its fair  
29 market value as determined by the sheriff. In regard to the sale of such  
30 firearms, the sheriff is not required to comply with any other law of this  
31 state regarding the sale of county property.

32  
33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
