Arkansas Code § 12-8-502(c), regarding the sharing of 25 information on child abuse investigations by local law enforcement agencies 26 27 with the Family Protection Unit of the Arkansas State Police, is amended to 28 read as follows: 29 "(c) The Family Protection Unit shall develop and maintain statewide statistics regarding the incidence of child abuse. Each county and city law 30 31 enforcement agency conducting child abuse investigations through referral from the child abuse hotline shall may report the status and disposition of these 32 33 investigations to the Family Protection Unit on a monthly basis, but the 34 agencies shall report the status and disposition of any completed 35 investigations which are referred to the prosecuting attorney's office and any 36 other investigations which are otherwise closed."
