## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A FACILITY TO HOUSE JUVENILE  
OFFENDERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"TO ESTABLISH A FACILITY TO HOUSE  
JUVENILE OFFENDERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF  
EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The Division of Youth Services of the Department of  
Human Services shall establish a separate facility to house offenders between  
the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) who have been committed to the  
Division of Youth Services.

(b) This facility shall be in operation by July 1, 2000 and shall be  
contingent upon funding.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
