"AN ACT TO ESTABLI SH A FACI LI TY TO HOUSE J UVENI LE OFFENDERS BETVEEN THE AGES OF EI GHTEEN AND TWENTY- ONE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"TO ESTABLI SH A FACI LI TY TO HOUSE J UVENI LE OFFENDERS BETVEEN THE AGES OF EI GHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. (a) The Divisi on of Youth Services of the Department of Human Services shall establish a separate facility to house of fenders bet ween the ages of ei ght een (18) and t wenty-one (21) who have been committed to the Di vi si on of Youth Services.
(b) This facility shall be in operation by July 1, 2000 and shall be contigent upon funding.

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of $t$ hi s Act of a general and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circunstance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the Act which can be given effect without the i nval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTI ON 4. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repeal ed.
