> EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the SECTION 5. Eighty-second General Assembly that the present law does not indicate how many members of the Arkansas Code Revision Commission are necessary to constitute a quorum; that in many instances a majority of the members have not been in attendance at meetings; that the legislator members are more likely to attend than the non-legislator members; that this act establishes a quorum to consist of a majority of the legislator members if a majority of the full membership is not in attendance; that the commission will need to meet much earlier than 91 days after adjournment of this Regular Session of the General Assembly; and that unless this emergency clause is adopted the commission might not be able to perform its duties until the codification of the acts of 1999 has been completed. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the
