6 (e) The chairman shall have the power to convene the commission at such 7 time as he may deem proper after due notice thereof to all the members of the 8 commission.

9 (f) The Arkansas State Police Commission is directed to hold a minimum 10 of one (1) meeting per month.

(g) Failure of any commissioner to attend three (3) consecutive
meetings, except for those absences due to illness of the commissioner, shall
constitute cause for removal from office by the Governor.

(h) A majority of the members of the commission shall constitute a
quorum to transact any business properly brought before it, and not
inconsistent with the provisions hereof. A quorum may do and perform other

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 34 act are declared to be severable.
