10 LEGISLATOR LICENSE PLATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
21 shall provide for and issue special Former Legislator license plates in the
22 manner and subject to the conditions prescribed herein.
23

24 SECTION 2. The special Former Legislator license plates shall be
25 designed by the Department of Finance and Administration.
26

27 SECTION 3. Upon payment of the fee required by law for registration of
28 the vehicle, payment of an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) handling and
29 administrative fee for the issuance of a special Former Legislator license
30 plate and presentation of proof of being a former member of the Arkansas
31 General Assembly, the Department of Finance and Administration shall issue a
32 Former Legislator license plate to the vehicle owner. The handling and
33 administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be deposited to the State
34 Central Services Fund for the benefit of the Revenue Division and shall be
35 credited to the Revenue Division as supplemental and in addition to all other
36 funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the Revenue Division. The

1 handling and administrative fee shall not be considered or credited to the
2 Revenue Division as "direct revenues".

3
4 SECTION 4. Special Former Legislator license plates issued under this
5 act may be renewed annually at the regular fee. Registration may continue
6 from year to year as long as it is renewed each year within the time and
7 manner required by law.

8
9 SECTION 5. Former Legislator license plates issued under this act may
10 be transferred from one vehicle to another pursuant to Arkansas Code § 27-14-
11 914.

12
13 SECTION 6. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration
14 shall promulgate such reasonable rules and regulations and prescribe such
15 forms as he determines to be necessary for effectively and efficiently
16 carrying out the intent and purposes of this act.

17
18 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
19 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
20 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

21
22 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
23 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
24 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
25 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
26 act are declared to be severable.

27
28 SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
29 hereby repealed.
