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9 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
10 SERVICES, OPERATING EXPENSES, AND DATA PROCESSING
11 SYSTEM/SERVICES FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF
12 STATE FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2001;
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

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16 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER
17 OF STATE - BIENNIAL OPERATIONS
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1999-2001
19 BIENNIUM. "

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
25 the Office of the Treasurer of State for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
30 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
31 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
32 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
33 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
34 successor.

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31 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the
 32 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following
 33 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 34 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten (10)
 35 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
 36 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its

1 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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3 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
 4 Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central
 5 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing
 6 system/services, and debt collection of the Office of the Treasurer of State
 7 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

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24 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 25 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.

26 At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000, any unexpended
 27 appropriation and funds provided for the Data Processing System/Services line
 28 item shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the
 29 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001.

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31 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 32 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 33 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 34 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 35 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 36 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

1 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 2 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 3 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 5 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 7 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 12 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 14 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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 18 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
 19 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 20 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 21 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 22 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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 24 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 25 this act are hereby repealed.

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 27 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 28 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
 29 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
 30 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
 31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 36 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.

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
