## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUI RE THE EARLY CHI LDHOOD EDUCATI ON
COMM SSI ON TO REPORT ANNUALLY TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

"AN ACT TO REQUI RE THE EARLY CHI LDHOOD
EDUCATI ON COMM SSI ON TO REPORT ANNUALLY
TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Arkansas Code 20-78-501 is amended to read as follows: "20-78-501. Creati on - Composition - Meetings.
(a) There is hereby established the Arkansas Early Chil dhood Comm ssi on to be composed of ei ght een (18) rembers appoi nted by the Governor, subj ect to confirmation by the Senate. The members of the commissi on shall serve for
 July 1. The chai rman of the comissi on shall be sel ected annually by maj ority vote of the commission.
(b) The membershi $p$ of the comi ssi on shall be as follows:
(1) Three (3) members affiliated with child care provi der agenci es, organi zations, or prograns;
(2) One (1) member affiliated with a Head Start program
(3) One (1) member affiliated with a Hl PPY program,
(4) One (1) member employed as an admi ni strator by a publ ic school district;
(5) One (1) menber empl oyed by a publ ic school di strict as a
teacher with early childhood responsi bilities;
(6) The Di rector of the Department of Health or her designee;
(7) One (1) member trai ned as early chil dhood education pr of essi onal s;
(8) One (1) member who is a parent of a child who attends a chil dcare program
(9) The Di rector of the Vocational and Techni cal Division of the Department of Education, or its successor, or his desi gnee;
(10) The Di rector of the General Education Division of the Department of Education or his desi gnee;
(11) Two (2) rembers representing the busi ness community who have an interest in early childhood education;
(13)(12) The chai $r$ of the House Subcomittee on Children and Youth of the House Comittee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legi sl ative and Mlitary Affairs or the chai r's desi gnee;
(14)(13) The chai $r$ of the Senate Comittee on Children and Youth or the chai r's desi gnee;
(15)(14) The chai $r$ of the House Committee on Educati on or the chai $r^{\prime}$ s desi gnee; and
(16)(15) The chai $r$ of the Senate Committee on Education or the chai $r^{\prime}$ s desi gnee.
(c) The commissi on shall meet at least quarterly and at such ot her times as may be deemed necessary for the performance of the duties of the commi ssion. Special meetings of the commission may be called by the chai ran or by agreement of a maj ority of the members of the commission.
(d) The members of the commi ssi on shall serve wi thout compensation or per diembut shall be entitled to rei mbursement for actual expenses incurred in the performance of duties as members of the commission. Expense rei mbursement shall be in accordance with state travel and official busi ness expense rei mbursement procedures and regul ations. Expense rei mbursement shal I be paid from funds appropriated to the Di vision of Child Care and Early Chil dhood Educati on for such purposes.
(e) Members of the commissi on serving on August 1, 1997, except those members whose positions have been el iminat by this act, shall continue to serve out their terns.
(f) The comissi on shall report annually to the House Education

## Committee and the Senate Education Committee as set out in Arkansas Code 20-78-502."

Section 2. Arkansas Code 20-78-502 is amended to read as follows:
"20-78-502. Duti es - Assi stance.
(a) The Arkansas Early Chil dhood Commissi on shall have the following duties and responsi bilities and shall annually report their progress toward the foll owing:
(1) Advi se the di vi si on on the admi ni stration of the Arkansas Child Care Facilities Loan Guar ant ee Trust Fund;
(2) Provi de techni cal assistance in design of training prograns to enhance the skills of professionals in early childhood prograns, including the devel opment of an annual comprehensi ve trai ning plan for provi ders;
(3) Exam ne the recommendations of national and regi onal groups and systens producing scientifically proven and cost effective results used by ot hers to provide child care and early chil dhood services;
(3)(4) Assist in devel opment of a comprehensive long-range plan for expansi on, devel opment, and implementation of early childhood prograns in Arkansas incl uding recommending allocation and expenditures of $f$ unds appropriated to the Arkansas Better Chance Program,
(4)(5) Facilitate coordi nation and commini cation among state agenci es provi ding early chil dhood prograns to promete nondupl ication and coor di nati on of services in such programs and recommend a structure for the admini strati on of the current existing prograns and the recommended progran®;
(5)(6) Advise the General Education Division of the Department of Education and ot her appropriate state agencies on the devel opment of programmatic standards for early childhood prograns to be funded with funds appropriated to the General Education Division or to such ot her state agenci es as may recei ve appropriations for such purposes;
(6)(7) Promte strong local commity support for early childhood education programs;
(7)(8) Promote publ i c awareness of childcare and early chil dhood prograns.
(b) The Di visi on of Child Care and Early Childhood Education shall assist the commission in carrying out its duties and responsibilities."

SECTI ON 3. All provisions of this act of a gener al and permant nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circunst ance is hel d i nval id, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act which can be gi ven effect wi thout the i nval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 5. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
