## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 6, CHAPTER 63,  
11 SUBCHAPTER 3 TO REQUIRE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
12 EDUCATION TO NOTIFY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WHEN HIGH  
13 SALARIED NEW HIRES ARE EMPLOYED FOR JOB DUTIES WHICH  
14 DIFFER FROM THOSE ENCOMPASSED WITHIN THE JOB TITLE  
15 ESTABLISHED BY LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 "TO REQUIRE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
19 EDUCATION TO NOTIFY THE LEGISLATIVE  
20 COUNCIL WHEN HIGH SALARIED NEW HIRES ARE

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 63, Subchapter 3 is amended  
29 to add the following section to appropriately numbered by the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission:

31 "(a) When any institution of higher education hereafter employs a  
32 person to be paid an annual salary in excess of one hundred thousand dollars  
33 (\$100,000) and that person's job duties do not comport with the job title  
34 established by law, the institution shall notify the Legislative Council  
35 regarding the difference between the job title and the new employee's actual  
36 duties.
