Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented 16 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Director of the Employment 17 18 Security Department is hereby authorized to make transfers from any 19 appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation made by this Act 20 with the exception of the "Reed Act Funds" appropriations set forth in Section 40 11 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or 21 22 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it 23 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this 24 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or items 25 26 which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be effected only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, however, 27 28 that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the total 29 amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General 30 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law.

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SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY

FORWARD. Any balance in the General Revenue funds made available by this Act

as matching funds for the Welfare-to-Work Initiative which remains on June 30,

2000, may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for the

same purpose.

SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING FUNDS ALLOCATION. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after review and recommendation from the state Workforce Investment Board and in coordination with the Arkansas Transitional Employment Board, will allocate the State General Revenue matching funds and other available welfare-to-work funds, in accordance with welfare-to-work priorities set by the state and in accordance with federal requirements. The Director, will implement an in-depth program evaluation process of welfare-to-work activities and report results to the Workforce Investment Board and the Transitional Employment Board.

SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

TRANSFER TO THE ARKANSAS WORKFORCE INVESTMENT FUND. In the event other funds are not available, of the funds made available to the Employment Security

Department from the Department of Human Services Fund from June 30, 1999

balances derived from savings in Welfare Reform Initiatives by the Department of Human Services during the 1998-99 fiscal year for a transfer by warrant for matching funds for Welfare-to-Work Grants for Transitional Employment

Assistance recipients six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) of these monies shall be transferred to Arkansas Workforce Investment Fund.

SECTION 26. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 27. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 28. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 29. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 30. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
