Visit pay shall not exceed \$45 per visit. Employees requested to be on-14 15 call and/or on standby for visiting on nights, weekends, and/or holidays will 16 be eligible to receive on-call pay not to exceed \$30 per day. 14	<u>the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective</u>
15	<u>date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the</u>
16	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19	<u>safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.</u>
