- 2 (C) If the address is not within the precinct, instruct the 3 voter to contact the county clerk's office to determine the proper precinct;
  - (6) If the voter's name is not the same as that on the precinct voter registration list, request the voter to complete a voter registration application form for purposes of updating county voter registration record files:
  - (7) Request the voter, in the presence of the election official to sign his name, including his given name, his middle name or initial, if any, and his last name in the space provided on the precinct voter registration list. If a person is unable to sign his signature or make his mark or cross, the election official shall enter his initials and the voter's date of birth in the space for the person's signature on the precinct voter registration list—; and
- 15 (8) To request the voter for purposes of signature verification 16 to provide a valid driver's license, a valid photo identification card issued by a governmental agency, voter card, Social Security card, Birth Certificate, 17 18 U. S. Passport, employee identification card issued by a governmental agency containing a photograph, employee identification card issued in the normal 19 20 course of business of the employer, a valid student identification card, a valid Arkansas hunting license, or a valid United States military 21 22 identification card.
