5 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Auditor of 6 State, to be payable from the Court Reporter's Fund, for personal services and 7 operating expenses of the official court reporters of the Circuit and Chancery 8 Courts for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

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19 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 20 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 21 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 22 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures 23 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 24 25 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 26 27 with in disbursement of said funds.

29 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 30 31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 34 35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

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2	SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
3	nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
4	Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6	SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
7	thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
8	not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
9	effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
10	provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

12	SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
13	this act are hereby repealed.

15	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
16	Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
17	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
18	the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
19	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
21	date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
22	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
23	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
24	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
25	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
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
