## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-3-201 (e) (2)
CONCERNI NG A TEMPORARY ANNUI TY UNDER A RETI REMENT PLAN COVERI NG ARKANSAS PUBLI C EMPLOYEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 24-3-201 (e)(2) is amended to read as follows:
" (2) (A) In addition, if a member has credited service resulting from empl oyment in a position covered at any time by social security or another federal retirement plan supported wholly or in part by employer contributions, and if that member is retiring as provided in subsections (a)-(d) of this section or § 24-3-207(a), and if that nember's age at retirement is younger than:
(i) Social security's mi mum age for an imedi ate retirement benefit; and
(ii) Age si xty-two (62),
then that member of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System shal l recei ve a temporary annuity equal to thirty-five thirty-three hundreths percent $(.35 \%)(.33 \%)$ of his final average pay for each year of such credited service.
(B) A similar menber of the State Police Retirement System shal I
recei ve a tempor ary annuity equal to three hundred twenty-two thousandths percent ( $0.322 \%$ of his final average pay for each year of credited service.
(C) The Except as provided in subdi vi si on (D), the tempor ary annuity shall terminate at the end of the cal endar month in which the earliest of the following events occurs:
(i) The member's death;
(ii) His attai nment of the social security mi mumage; or
(iii) His attai nment of age sixty-two (62).
(D) If the member does not receive soci al security benefits at age sixty-two (62) then the member shall recei ve fifty percent $(50 \%$ of the temporary annuity for an additional twenty-four (24) months or until the menber begins to draw social security benefits, whichever occurs first. The menber must sign a rel ease form authorizing the appropriate systemto verify the member's status with the Social Security Administration. The member shall notify the appropriate system i meedi at el y upon recei ving soci al security benefits."

SECTI ON 2. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shal l be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement systems unf unded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be i mpl emented by any publ icly supported system whi ch has unf unded act uari al accrued I i abilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years until the unf unded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.

SECTI ON 3. All provisions of $t$ hi s act of a general and permant nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annot ated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 4. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circumstance is hel d i nval id, such i nval idity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the act which can be given effect without the i nval id provi si on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.


SECTI ON 5. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are her eby repeal ed.
