## For An Act To Be Entitled

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10 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 8-6-204(a)(2)(A)(ii) TO  
11 CORRECTLY DESIGNATE VIOLATIONS SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL  
12 SANCTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

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15 "AN ACT TO AMEND CRIMINAL PROVISIONS  
16 CONCERNING SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-204(a)(2)(A)(ii) is amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "(ii) Through the course of activities prohibited by this section,  
24 ~~commit a violation of § 8-4-103 (a)(2)(A)(i) purposely, knowingly, or~~  
25 recklessly cause pollution of the waters or air of the state in a manner not  
26 otherwise permitted by law and thereby create a substantial likelihood of  
27 adversely affecting human health, animal or plant life, or property; or"

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29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.

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
