SECTION 40. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 23 24 Eighty-second General Assembly that changes in the state's fiscal laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year and that if the current 25 26 legislative session is extended such that the 90 period is later than July 1, 1999 such changes will not be timely.
