21 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>ATTORNEY</u> 23 <u>FEES.</u> The disbursing officer of the appropriations provided for herein, shall 24 deposit all monies received by the Office of Attorney General as attorney fees 25 in the State Central Services Fund as direct revenues.

27 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary 30 31 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of 32 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 33 34 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 35 with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 6 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 8 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 19. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 20. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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20 SECTION 21. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 21 this act are hereby repealed.

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23 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 24 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that 25 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of 26 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 28 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the 29 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999. 34

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
