21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Office of Attorney General for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
29 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ATTORNEY FEES. The disbursing officer of the appropriations provided for herein, shall deposit all monies received by the Office of Attorney General as attorney fees in the State Central Services Fund as direct revenues.

SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 8 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9
 10 SECTION 19. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
 11 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
 12 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

13
 14 SECTION 20. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
 15 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
 16 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
 17 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
 18 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

19
 20 SECTION 21. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 21 this act are hereby repealed.

22
 23 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
 24 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
 25 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
 26 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
