16	(b) The foundation shall refer severely disabled persons to appropriate		
17	divisions, departments, and other state agencies to assure that maximum		
18	available rehabilitative services can be obtained by the amputee disabled		
19	person if the person so desires. The foundation shall also assign a volunteer		
20	counselor to work with the amputee and his family during rehabilitation.		
21	(c) All other agencies shall cooperate with the foundation to insure		
22	that appropriate total rehabilitative and other services and records are
