## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-209 (b) CONCERNING  
10 DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE UNIFORM  
11 ALLOWANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT CONCERNING DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
15 STATE POLICE UNIFORM ALLOWANCES."  
16  
17

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-8-209 (b), concerning Department of  
21 Arkansas State Police uniform allowances, is amended to read as follows:

22 "(b)(1)(A) *The amounts payable for uniform allowance shall not exceed*  
23 *one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) per annum for each state police*  
24 *colonel, lieutenant colonel, major, captain, lieutenant, sergeant, corporal,*  
25 *trooper first class, drug diversion manager, drug diversion investigator, and*  
26 *trooper. However, each state police trooper in his first year of service may*  
27 *receive up to, but not to exceed, two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for uniform*  
28 *allowance during the first year.*

29 (B) If funds are available, the director may increase the  
30 uniform allowance to not more than two thousand four hundred dollars (\$2,400)  
31 per annum.

32 (2) Each telecommunications supervisor, telecommunications  
33 operator, and driver's license examiner may receive up to, but shall not  
34 exceed, one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum for uniform allowance."  
35

36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3  
4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9  
10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
