## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. REGULAR SALARI ES - VARI OUS DI VI SI ONS AND ARCHEOLOGI CAL SURVEY. There is hereby established for the Uni versity of Arkansas - Various Divisions and the Archeol ogical Survey for the 1999-2001 bi enni um the following maximum number of regular empl oyees whose sal aries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uni formClassification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximumal sal ary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt fromthe provisions of said Uniform Cl assification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herei $n$ are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regul ar Sal aries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTI ON 8. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW REFUND TO

EXPENDI TURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity or redemptions of i nvestments as authorized in Section $6 \underline{7}$ of this Act for the Uni versity of Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Programshall be deemed "Ref unds to Expenditures" for all moni es invested.

SECTI ON 9. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW GRANTS AND CONTRACTS. The Arkansas Archeol ogi cal Survey is authorized to ent er into contracts with and to recei ve and expend gifts, grants, or other funds from federal, private, or other sources to be used in further ance of the program of the Survey within the limitations of the maximumnual sal ary rates as set forth in this Act.

SECTI ON 10. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW USE AND DI SBURSI NG OFFI CER. The funds appropriated under Section $3 \underline{4}$ and allocat ed in Item (5) of Section $4 \underline{5}$ of this Act are to be used for the personal services and maintenance and gener al oper ation of the Arkansas Archeol ogi cal Survey and for no ot her purpose. The Vi ce-President for Fi nance and Admi ni stration of the Uni versity of Arkansas is hereby made the di sbursing officer for the appropriati on made by this Act.

SECTI ON 11. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL ALLOMANCES. For the pur pose of provi ding necessary allowances for housing and ot her unusual expenses incurred by or on behal f of the athletic directors, associ ate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches, assistant coaches, of fensi ve coor di nators, defensi ve coordi nators, and head trai ners in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances available ther ef or in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties of said athl et c di rectors, associ ate and assistant athletic di rectors, head coaches, assi stant coaches, of fensi ve coordi nators, def ensive coordi nat ors, and head trai ners in the men's and momen's Athl et ic Departments at the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such allowances, the

Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary income of the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from athletic event recei pts, or from contributions fromsources other than state funds, an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such purposes during each year of the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um for the at hl etic directors, associ ate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an arount not to exceed one thousand dol lars (\$1,000) each for the assistant athletic directors, and assi stant coaches, of fensi ve coordi nat ors, def ensi ve coordi nat ors, and head trai ners. Any such allowances shall be in addition to the regul ar sal ary of such athletic di rectors, associ ate and assi stant athletic di rectors, head coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herei $n$ are utilitzed the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall report annually to the Arkansas Legi sl ative Joint Auditing Committee the exact di sposition of the those special allowance funds authorized herein.

In recognition of the extra work invol ved in the participation of i ntercollegi ate athletic teans in post-season competition, and to promote exceptional achi evement in the total sports program the Chancellor of the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by the Board of Trustees of the Uni versity of Arkansas, may approve additional compensation of up to one month's sal ary for the Athletic Department and Band personnel when any athletic teamparticipates in post-season competition or achi eves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regul ar sal aries authorized by law, provi ded that the additional compensation shall be paid from contributions fromsources other than public funds.

SECTI ON 12. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW POSI TI ONS AND FUNDS RESTRI CTED. None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated herei $n$ shall be used for the support of the Sci ence Information Li ai son Of fe (SILO) program the Commity Assi stance Program or their successor prograns. All assets and funds allocated to the SI LO programshall be transferred to the Bureau of Legislative Research, to be used for research and constituency services for the 135 members of the Arkansas General Assembly.

SECTI ON 13. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW ADDI TI ONAL

PAYMENTS AUTHORI ZED. The Board of Trustees of the Uni versity of Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville, fromrevenues generated by contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such anounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the coaches of consulting and other obl igations pursuant to contracts bet ween the Uni versity and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall not be consi dered sal ary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum sal aries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted el sewhere in Arkansas stat utes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to coaches at the Uni versity of Arkansas, Fayetteville.

SECTI ON 14. COMPLIANCE WTH OTHER LAMS. Di sbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regul ar Sal ary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Hi gher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or thei $r$ successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regul ations proml gated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in di sbursement of said funds.

SECTI ON 15. LEGI SLATI VE I NTENT. I t is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evi denced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contai ned in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Fi nance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimon in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Comittee which rel ate to its passage and adoption.

SECTI ON 16. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Comission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 17. SEVERABI LITY. If any provi si on of thi s act or the appl ication thereof to any person or circumstance is hel dinvalid, such inval idity shall not affect other provi si ons or applications of the act whi ch can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 18. GENERAL REPEALER. Al I I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It i s her eby found and det er mi ned by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohi bits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of $t$ his Act on July 1,1999 is essential to the oper at ion of the agency for whi ch the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regul ar Session, the del ay in the effective date of this Act beyond ${ }^{\text {d }}$ y 1,1999 could work i rreparable harm upon the proper admi nistration and provision of essential governmental prograns. Ther ef ore, an emergency is hereby decl ared to exi st and this Act being necessary for the i meedi ate preservation of the public peace, heal th and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
