For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 20-84-102 TO REVISE THE METHOD FOR SELECTING THE LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS TO THE ARKANSAS WOMEN'S COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

Subtitle

"TO REVISE THE METHOD FOR SELECTING THE LEGISLATIVE MEMBERS TO THE ARKANSAS WOMEN'S COMMISSION. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-84-102(a)(3), regarding the legislative members of the Arkansas Women's Commission, is amended to read as follows:

"(3) There shall be two (2) legislative members of the commission. One (1) member shall be a member of the Senate and one (1) member shall be a member of the House of Representatives. They shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, respectively and there shall be one (1) member each being from the two (2) major political parties in Arkansas. In the event there are no female members elected to the Arkansas Senate, the two (2) legislative members shall be from the House, one (1) member each being from the two (2) major political parties in Arkansas, and they shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Speaker."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
