"AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS I NCOME TAX ACT TO REVI SE THE M NI MUM GROSS I NCOME LEVELS AT WHI CH VARI OUS TYPES OF TAXPAYERS ARE REQUI RED TO FI LE ARKANSAS I NDI VI DUAL I NCOME TAX RETURNS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

Subtitle<br>" REVI SES THE M NI MUM GROSS I NCOME LEVELS<br>AT WHI CH VARI OUS TAXPAYERS ARE REQUI RED to file arkansas indi vi dual i ncome tax RETURNS. "

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code 26-51-801(a) and (b) are amended to read as foll ows:
"(a) Every person ouning property or doing busi ness in the State of Arkansas shall file a return with the Director of the Department of Finance and Admini stration showing his gross income and the deductions or credits allowed by §§ 26-51-301, 26-51-302, and 26-51-436 if he has a gross income of:
(1) Two thousand one hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 2,150)$ Three thousand ni ne-hundred ni nety-ni ne dollars $(\$ 3,999)$ if married and not filing jointly or married but living apart fromthe spouse at the end of the income year or on the date the spouse died;
(2) Five thousand five hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 5,550)$ Seven thousand ei ght hundred dollars $(\$ 7,800)$ if single and under sixty-five (65) years of age;
(3) Six thousand four hundred dollars $(\$ 6,400)$ Ni ne thousand
three hundred dollars $(\$ 9,300)$ if single and sixty-five (65) years of age or over;
(4) Seven thousand one hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 7,150)$ Twel ve thousand one hundred dollars $(\$ 12,100)$ if head of househol $d$ and under sixtyfive (65) years of age;
(5) Eight thousand dollars (\$8,000) Thi rteen thousand dol I ars $(\$ 13,000)$ if head of househol d and sixty-five (65) years of age or over;
(6) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) Fifteen thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 15,500)$ if married, filing jointly, and both spouses are under si xty-five (65) years of age;
(7) Fen thousand six hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 10,650)$ Fifteen thousand six hundred dollars $(\$ 15,600)$ if married, filing jointly, and one spouse is sixty-five (65) years of age or ol der;
(8) Eleven thousand three hundred dollars (\$11,300) Si xt een thousand t wo hundred dollars $(\$ 16,200)$ if married, filing jointly, and both spouses are sixty-five (65) years of age or over;
(9) Seven thousand eight hundred fifty dollars $(\$ 7,850)$ Fifteen thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 15,500)$ if a qual ifying widow or wi dower with a dependent child and under sixty-five (65) years of age;
(10) Eight thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 8,500)$ Si xt een thousand dollars $(\$ 16,000)$ if a qual ifying wi dow or wi dower with a dependent child and sixty-five (65) years of age or over.
(b) If husband and wi fe are living toget her and have an aggregate gross i ncome of ten thousand dollars $(\$ 10,000)$ fifteen thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 15,500)$ or over, each shall make a ret urn unl ess the income of each is i ncl uded in a single j oi nt ret urn."

SECTI ON 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permant nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revisi on Comi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 3. If any provisi on of this act or the appl ication ther eof to any person or circumstance is hel d i nval id, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or appl ications of the act which can be given effect without the i nval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

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SECTION 4. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.
