18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-75-605(a) is hereby amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(a) Any city levying a tax pursuant to this subchapter shall, by
23 ordinance, create a city advertising and promotion commission, to be composed
24 of seven (7) members, as follows:

25 (1) Four (4) members shall be owners or managers of businesses in the
26 tourism industry, and the owner or manager shall reside in the levying city
27 or, if the governing body of the city provides for by ordinance, the owner or
28 manager may reside outside of the city but within the county in which the city
29 is located, at least three (3) of whom shall be owners or managers of hotels,
30 motels, or restaurants, and who shall serve for staggered terms of four (4)
31 years;

32 (2) ~~Two (2) members~~ One (1) member of the commission shall be a ~~members~~
33 member of the governing body of the city and selected by the governing body
34 and shall serve at the will of the governing body; ~~and~~

35 (3) One (1) member shall be the mayor; and,

36 ~~(3)(4)~~ (4) One (1) member shall be from the public at large, who shall

1 reside within the levying city, and shall serve for a term of four (4) years.”

3 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 Act are declared to be severable.

13 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
14 hereby repealed.
